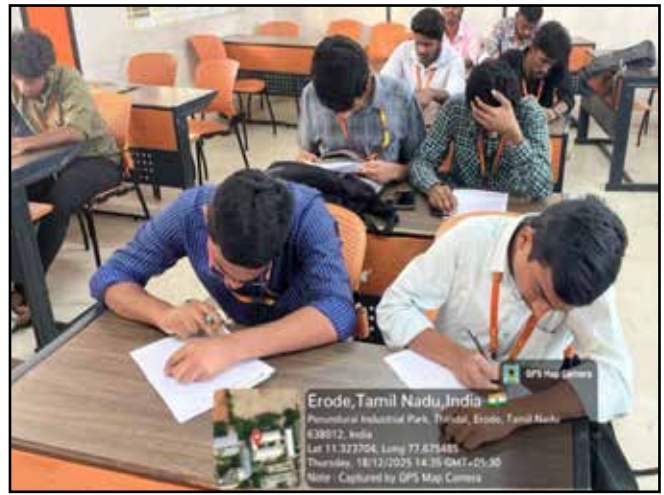

The newly inaugurated 3 MMUs will strengthen the delivery of essential healthcare services to rural and underserved communities in Ramanathapuram, Sivagangai and Theni Districts.





During November and December 2025, Mobile Medical Unit Camps were successfully conducted across seven districts, ensuring delivery of essential healthcare services to underserved communities. In November 2025 alone, the MMU teams served 17,127 beneficiaries, with medicines worth ₹3,30,570 procured and distributed.

The outreach continued effectively in December 2025, covering the same seven districts and benefiting 17,767 individuals, during which medicines worth ₹3,21,400/- were utilized.

Throughout both months, the MMU teams rendered comprehensive services including home visits, wound dressings, nebulization, and timely medical referrals.

In addition, multiple beneficiaries were facilitated with referrals to nearby Government health facilities for further evaluation and advanced treatment, thereby strengthening access to quality healthcare and ensuring continuity of medical care for the communities served.
